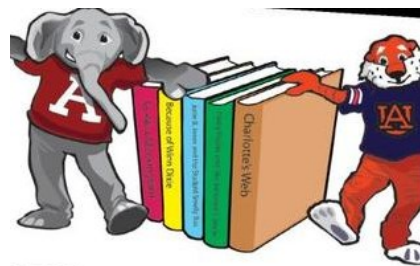

Brochures for Issue 6 of the Book Club have been sent home tonight with the newsletter. Orders with the correct money are due back to school no later than Friday, August 28.

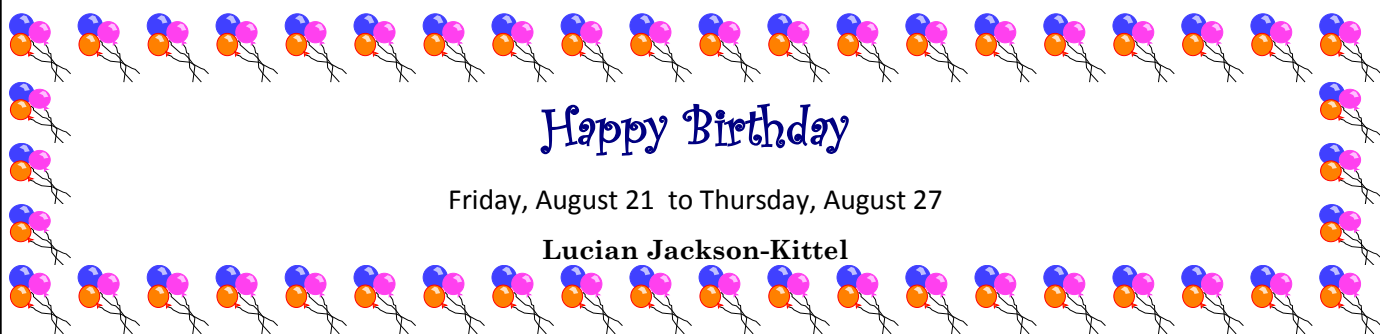


Earn & Learn Stickers
