## Swimming Program

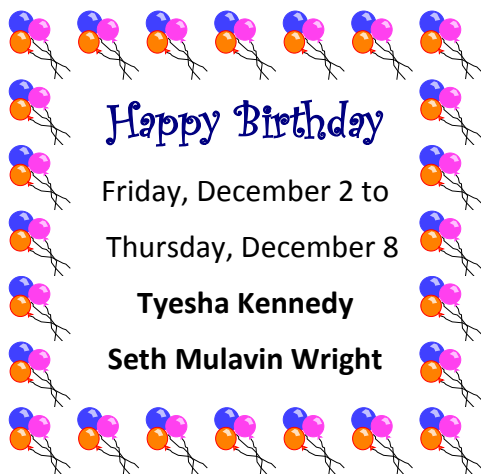
