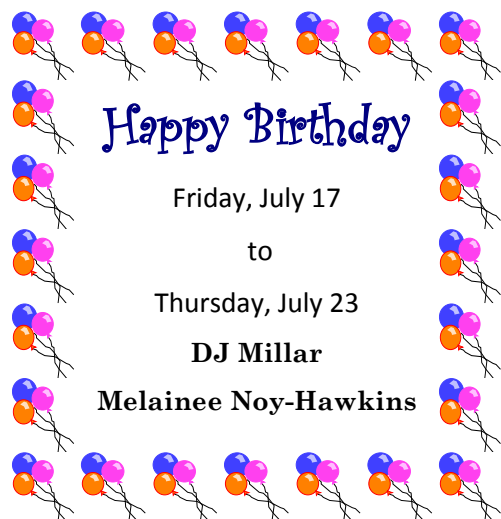
## Active After School
