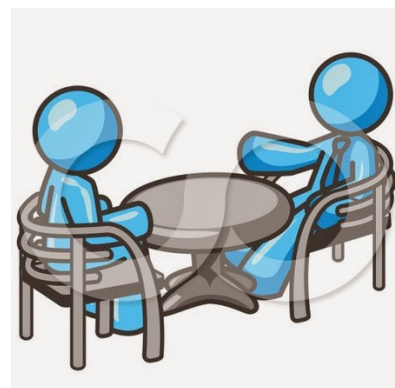

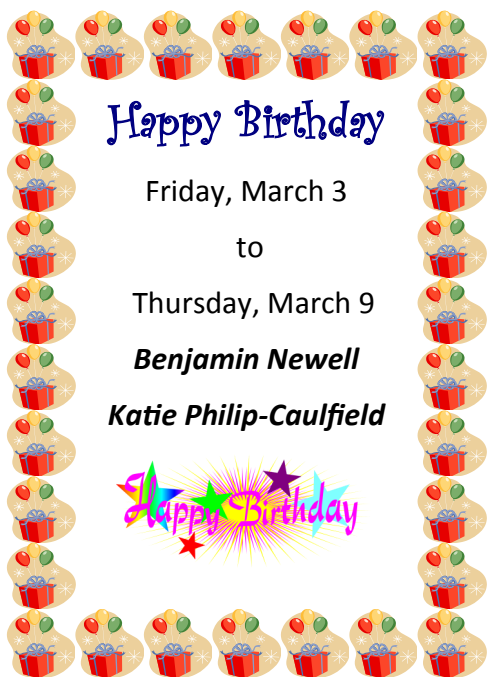
## Building Update
