All classes except our Preps will be visiting the Newcomb Library next Monday afternoon. Students will be walking down and back, accompanied by their teachers and class Aides.

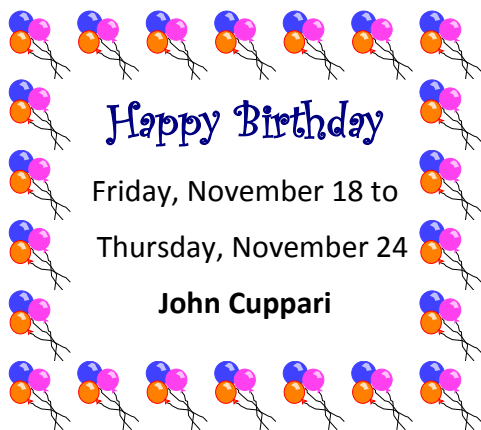
