Life Education Van

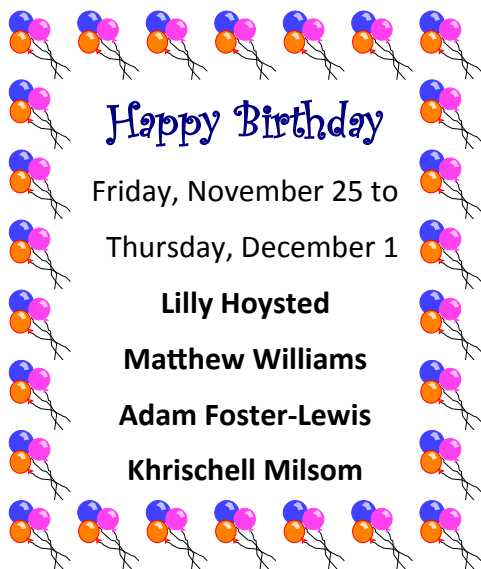
