***Ask your child to tell you what it means.***

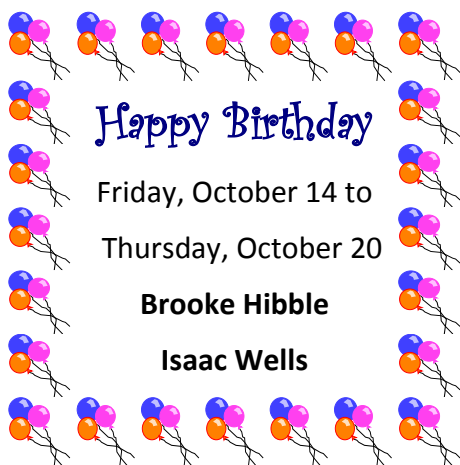
