Term 4-Sunsmart

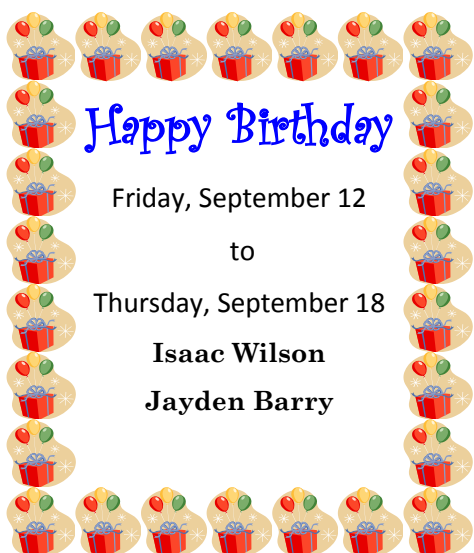

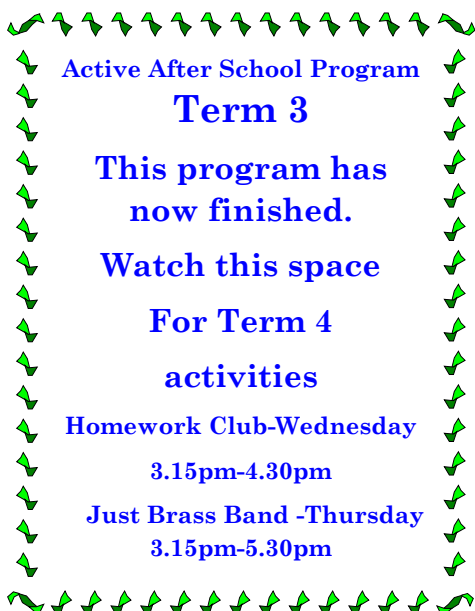
